

## Update to AIM Specialty Health sleep disorder management clinical appropriateness guidelines

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Effective for dates of service on and after January 28, 2019, CPT code A7047 (oral interface used with respiratory suction pump) will be removed from the AIM Specialty Health<sup>®</sup> (AIM), a separate company, sleep disorder management clinical appropriateness guidelines and will no longer apply.
